The image should be 5 inches or more. Using crayons, markers, or pencils make enhancements or changes to the features of the face. Describe why you made the choices you did.</p>	<p>Math: Number Lines Create a how-to video, index card, or song that teaches your classmates how to label a fraction on a number line. Show at least three examples of number lines with fractions labeled correctly.</p>
<p>Science: Write a short descriptive paper about what you know (or research) on stars. Include the life cycle of a star.</p>	<p>Math: Why Fractions? Why do we need fractions in real life?
