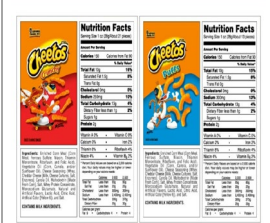
The circumference of the **Equator** is approximately 24,900 miles. Based on this, how fast is Quito, Ecuador (Q), traveling due to the rotation of the Earth? Havana, Cuba, lies on the **Tropic of Cancer**, which has a circumference of approximately 18,000 miles. Fairbanks, Alaska, lies on the **Arctic Circle**, which has a circumference of approximately 10,000 miles. How fast is each city traveling due to the rotation of the Earth? Remember that we would measure this in miles per hour and the Earth makes one full rotation in 24 hours.

Imagine you're having a sale on hoodies... look at the offers below. Without calculating anything, circle the offer that you expect will be the best deal. Once you're done, calculate the actual prices to see if you were right.
