<p>Pick 4 vocabulary words that you don't know the meaning of in an article or a book you are reading. Complete the following for each word:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Your own definition -A picture of the word -A synonym -Use it in a sentence 	<p>Design a quilt square to go along with what you know about the Underground Railroad. This can be completed on paper or on the computer.</p>	<p>Music: Listen to a song. Write down the title, artist, and a paragraph describing how this relates to your day (mood or activity, etc.)</p>	<p>Look up a restaurant menu or make one up and order one beverage, appetizer, entrée, and dessert for each of your family members (must have at least 4 family members). Add up your bill on paper. Don't worry about the tip and tax.</p>

Add all the colors/fractions together. Find the differences from the colors/fractions.</p>	<p>Write a letter to a friend convincing them to read your favorite book. The current coronavirus pandemic is something that nobody has ever experienced before, and you are part of this history. Write a one-page document of what life is like during this time!</p>
